Parent Engagement at La Causa Charter School



What is parent engagement?

Parents who are engaged with their student's school are parents who participate in school activities and groups, often becoming part of the school's decision-making process. These parents work together with the school to improve the learning, development, and health of the students.



Parent involvement and **Parent engagement** are similar and lead to the same positive outcomes, but they do have differences.

Parent involvement includes:

- Volunteering in the classroom
- Chaperoning school events & field trips
- Participating in parent-teacher conferences
- Participating in Time to Shine

Parent *engagement* includes participating in school meetings that give parents the opportunity to offer their own input on school-wide decisions. At La Causa Charter School, examples of these meetings would be the School Governance Council and PTO.



Parent Engagement at La Causa Charter School

Why is parent engagement at school so important?

Parent engagement has positive impacts on:

- Academic Performance: Parent engagement enhances the academic performance of the student.
- **Student Well-being:** Parent engagement has a positive influence on student attitude and behavior in the classroom.
- The Parent/Family: The parent/family gets a
 better understanding of how the child is
 performing academically and socially. When a
 parent is engaged at the school, they stay
 informed about the school curriculum and
 activities, thus being more comfortable with the
 quality of education their child is receiving and
 what goes on in the classroom.
