



PARENTAL AGREEMENT CONTINUED

CRISIS NURSERY EXPECTATIONS

(initial)

The Crisis Nursery staff are Certified Child Care Providers that will care for and nurture your child during their stay here. At the time you pick up your child(ren) you may review their daily record sheet and any incident report forms that may have been completed. A copy can be made if you would like to take it with you. We will make every effort to keep track of items brought in by children. Please make sure your child's belongings are marked with their name and that only necessary items are brought with your child. In the event that another family has an emergency, families utilizing the center may be asked to pick up so that the emergency can be accommodated. If we ask you to pick up your child we will attempt to reschedule you at a time of your choice.

It is essential that parents arrive at the scheduled times. Other intakes and discharges, as well as the Center routine, is dependent upon this. The program recognizes that children with special needs can be very demanding and caring for them may be stressful, and every effort will be made to work with and accommodate children with special needs. However, when a child is unmanageable and puts the safety of staff and other children at risk someone must be available to pick up the child immediately. Parents should maintain contact with the staff while their child(ren) are staying at the Center, with at least one call per day. Because emergencies can happen, parents must remain in the Milwaukee County area while their children are at the Center.

MEDICATION AND COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

(initial)

All children will be checked for communicable diseases upon arriving at the facility. If you are utilizing the center for a non-emergency reason, children that are sick will be rescheduled. Also in non-emergency situations, if there is a concern about something communicable on a child (lice, ringworm, etc.) the children will be rescheduled after treatment has occurred. We will administer medication to your child accurately. Please note that our policy is to follow the dosage directions that are on the prescription bottle. Therefore, medication must be brought in the original, current, prescription bottle and dosages will only be modified if there is a note from a doctor which modifies the prescription. For the health and safe of your child, the center may not admit children that do not have their medication with them.

INFORMED CONSENT FOR PROGRAM EVALUATION

(initial)

The Crisis Nursery periodically conducts evaluations of our services. Part of our evaluation involves asking parents questions about how services affect them and their families. This way we are able to show program results to our funders. A staff member or student intern may review questions with you in person or over the phone. Your participation is strictly voluntary. You may choose not to answer some questions, or not participate at all. Your ability to access service will not in any way be affected by your participation. Your privacy will be protected. All surveys are anonymous. Your identity, your child's identity and that of any other family member will not be disclosed in any way.
